560-2-2-.01 Definitions- General Provisions: This Rule provides definitions as used in these regulations, provides for grammatical changes. Was last amended in 2007.

560-2-2-.14 Coupons and Rebates- General Provisions: This Rules provides foe the regulation of coupons and rebates for alcoholic beverages. Changes to reflect current code and was adopted in 1997.

560-2-2-.17 Trade Practices- Inventory Set and Resets; Notification- General Provisions: This Rule provides for regulations regarding setting and re-setting inventory by wholesalers upon delivery alcoholic beverages to a retailer. Rule reflects changes in the code and was amended in 2008.

560-2-2-.18 Trade Practices- Point of Sale Advertising- General Provisions: This Rule provides for regulations regarding setting and re-setting inventory by wholesalers upon delivery alcoholic beverages to a retailer. This Rule reflects the changes in the code and was adopted in 2007.

560-2-2-.19 Trade Practices- Promotional Items and Marketing events- General Provisions: This Rule provides for regulations regarding types of promotional and marketing events or materials that may be provided. This Rule reflects changes in the Code and was amended in 2008.

560-2-2-.20 Promotional Events- General Provisions: This Rule provides for regulations regarding promotional events. Rule reflects the changes in code and was amended in 2008.

560-2-2-.22 Trade Show- General Provisions: This Rule provides for regulations of trade shows involving alcoholic beverages and for who may host these kinds of functions. This Rule reflects changes in Code and was amended in 2008.

560-2-2-.23 Manufacturer, Shipper and Wholesaler to Make Accurate Invoice- General Provisions: This Rule provides for regulations, reflects changes in Code and was amended in 2002.

560-2-3-.08 Retailer and Retail Consumption Dealer Purchase from Licensed Wholesaler, Penalty for Violation- Retailer/Retail Consumption Dealer: This Rule provides that a retailer or retail consumption dealer must purchase alcoholic beverages form a licensed wholesaler. Rule provides for a penalty for violation of this Regulation. Provides for grammatical changes, provides for changes in the Code and was adopted in 1982.

560-2-3-.12 Retailer License- Retailer/Retail Consumption Dealer: This Rule provides the necessary requirements for obtaining a retailer license in this State. Provides that the Regulations are cumulative and the requirements set forth in this Rule are not in lieu of any other laws, rules or regulations. Provides that a licensee must have a separate license for each place of business. Rule states that no license will be issued if the applicant is to make any payment such as, but not limited to, rent or management fee, based upon the profits of such licensed store. Provides for grammatical changes and was amended in 2008.

560-2-4-.04 Transportation of Distilled Spirits; Limitations- Wholesaler: This Rule provides for limitations on the delivery of distilled spirits. This Rule provides that a licensed wholesaler shall not transport, or caused to be transported, any distilled spirits to any point outside this State without the special approval of the Commissioner. This Rule provides for grammatical changes, changes in the Code and was amended in 1993.

560-2-4-.07 Wholesaler Price Lists for Distilled Spirits and Malt Beverages- Wholesaler: This Rule provides that every licensed Wholesaler must post a price list with the Commissioner. This Rule provides that the price list must include a list of all Alcohol Types, Brands, Brand Labels and sizes of distilled spirits that are being handled by licensed Wholesaler for each designated sales territory. This Rule provides that prices are effective at the date of posting, and that the price shall remain until amended. Provides the regulations for offering quantity discounts for distilled spirits, including that such quantity discounts be offered to all Retailers and Retail

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Consumption Dealers in the Wholesaler's sales territory. Provides for grammatical changes and was amended in 2008.

560-2-5-.11 Allocation of Designated Brands- Manufacturers, Shippers, Importers & Brokers: This Rule provides for the allocation and designation of brands to particular retailers or retail consumption dealer. New Rule

560-2-13-.01 Alcoholic Beverage Catering; Qualifications- Alcoholic Beverage Catering: This Rule provides that any establishment that complies with the provisions contained in Georgia laws and regulations, shall be authorized to sell, transport, deliver and dispense alcoholic beverages for which a license was obtained. Provides for the requirements necessary for a caterer to qualify as an alcoholic beverage caterer. This Rule provides for changes in the Code and was last amended in 1993.

560-11-8-.01 Headings- Intangible Recording Tax: This is intended to repeal 560-11-8-.01, "Purpose of Regulations: and replace with "Headings". This Rule provides that the headings in these regulations are for convenience only. This rule was adopted in 1996.

560-11-8-.02 Definitions- Intangible Recording Tax: This is intended to repeal 560-11-8-.03, "Definitions" and replace it with 560-11-8-.02, "Definitions." This Rule provides for the definitions to be used throughout these regulations. This Rule was adopted in 1996.

560-11-8-.03 Tax Payment and Rate- Intangible Recording Tax: This is intended to repeal 560-11-8-.02, "Tax Payment and Rate" and replace it with 560-11-8-.03, "Tax Payment and Rate." This Rule provides for situations in which Intangible Recording Tax is due and payable, provides for calculating the amount of Intangible Recording Tax, for the maximum amount of Intangible Recording Tax due on each note that comprises the same debt. This Rule was adopted in 1996.

560-11-8-.04 Interest Included in Note Add-On- Intangible Recording Tax: This is intended to repeal 560-11-8-.10, "Interest Included in Note-Add On" and replace it with 560-11-8-.04 "Interest Included in Note Add-On." This Rule provides for payment of Intangible Recording Tax on interest that becomes part of the principal amount of the loan. This Rule was adopted in 1996.

560-11-8-.05 Refinancing of Debt; Additional Advance- Intangible Recording Tax: This is intended to repeal 560-11-8-.05, "refinancing", and 560-11-.06, "Additional Advance" and combine and replace them with 560-11-8-.05, "Refinancing of Debt; Additional Advance." This Rule provides that no Intangible Recording Tax is due on amounts representing unpaid principal during a refinance. This Rule provides for the collection of Intangible Recording Tax for any new monies advanced to the borrower, regardless of a refinance or extension of additional credit. This Rule was adopted in 1996.

560-11-8-.06 Duty of Collecting Officer- Intangible Recording Tax: This is intended to combine portions of 560-11-8-.06 "Additional Advance" and 560-11-8-.08 "Multi-County Property" and adopt 560-11-8-.06, "Duty of Collecting Officer." This Rule provides the duties of the Collecting Officer for the calculation and collection of Intangible Recording Tax. This Rule was adopted in 1996.

560-11-8-.07 Multi-State Property- Intangible Recording Tax: This is an amended Rule. This rule provides the manner in which Intangible Recording Tax is calculated when the property encumbered is in Georgia and another state. This Rule provides that residents are required to pay Intangible Recording Tax on the full amount of the note, unless they provide an affidavit specifying the value of the property located in Georgia. This Rule provides that non-residents may apportion the Intangible Recording Tax based upon the value of the property located in Georgia. This rule was adopted in 1996.

560-11-8-.08 Multi-County Property- Intangible Recording Tax: This is an amended Rule. This Rule provides the method for collecting Intangible Recording Tax when the encumbered property is in more than one county. This Rule was adopted in 1996.

560-11-8-.09 Wrap-around Note- Intangible Recording Tax: This is an amended Rule. This Rule provides for payment of Intangible Recording Tax on Wrap-around Notes. This Rule was adopted in 1996.

560-11-8-.10 Adjustable Rate Mortgages- Intangible Recording Tax: This is intended to repeal 560-11-8-.11, "Adjustable Rate Mortgages ("ARM")" and replace it with 560-11-8-.10, "Adjustable Rate Mortgages." This Rule provides that Intangible Recording Tax is due on Adjustable Rate Mortgages if any interest becomes part of the principal amount of the indebtedness. This Rule was adopted in 1996.

560-11-8-.11 Instrument Securing Short-term and Long-term Noted- Intangible Recording Tax: This is intended

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to repeal 560-11-8-.12, "Instrument Securing Short-term and Long-term Noted" and replacing it with 560-11-8-.11, "Instrument Securing Short-term and Long-term Noted." This rule provides that Intangible Recording Tax is due on both Long-Term and Short-term Notes when used to secure a single Security Instrument that represent parts of the same debt. This rule provides that Intangible Recording Tax is not due on Short-term Notes that do not make up part of the same debt as the Long-term Note. This Rule was adopted in 1996.

560-11-8-.12 Secured Lines of Credit- Intangible Recording Tax: This Rule is intended to repeal 560-11-8-.13, "Secured Lines of Credit" and replace it with 560-11-8-.12, "Secured Lines of Credit." This Rule provides that Intangible Recording Tax is due on secured lines of credit. This Rule was adopted in 1996.

560-11-8-.13 Exemptions- Intangible Recording Tax: This is intended to repeal 560-11-8-.04, "Modifications: and 560-11-8-.14 "Exemptions: and combine and replace them with 560-11-8-.13, "Exemptions." This Rule provides exemptions from Intangible Recording Tax. This rule was adopted in 1996.

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560-11-8-.14 Determination Letter Requests for Prospective Transactions- Intangible Recording Tax: This is intended to repeal 560-11-8-.15, "Determination Letter Requests" and replace it with 560-11-8-.14, "Determination Letter Requests for Prospective Transactions." This rule provides for requirements regarding a request for a letter of determination by the Commissioner, of Intangible Recording Tax that may be due on specific transactions. This Rule was adopted in 1996.
