**Summary** Rule 391-3-1-.01 Definition of “Procedures for Testing and Monitoring Sources of Air Pollutants” or “PTM”  
The basis of this rule is to provide definitions for terms used in the Georgia Air Quality Control Rules, Chapter 391-3-1. The purpose of this revision is to reference the most recent version of the Procedures for Testing and Monitoring Sources of Air Pollutants. This revision is administrative in nature and does not incur any additional costs to the Environmental Protection Division or the regulated industry. No costs will be imposed on local governments or the general public.

Rule 391-3-1-.02(2) – Gasoline Transport Vehicles and Vapor Collection Systems  
The basis of this subparagraph is to specify work practice, design, testing, and reporting requirements for vehicles used for the transport of gasoline and for systems that capture gasoline vapors that are displaced from the vessel being loaded. The purpose of this revision is to correct a numbering error. This revision is administrative in nature and does not incur any additional costs to the Environmental Protection Division or the regulated industry. No costs will be imposed on local governments or the general public.

Rule 391-3-1-.02(2) – Multipollutant Control for Electric Utility Steam Generating Units  
The basis of this subparagraph is to require the installation and operation of specific air pollution control equipment on specified power plant units. The purpose of this revision is to insert a missing word. Insertion of the missing word does not result in a substantive change to the provisions of the subparagraph. This revision is administrative in nature and does not incur any additional costs to the Environmental Protection Division or the regulated industry. No costs will be imposed on local governments or the general public.

Rule 391-3-1-.02(8) – New Source Performance Standards  
The basis of this rule is to adopt the Federal New Source Performance Standards by reference. The purpose for this revision is to adopt new standards and reformat and update the entire rule in order to include all changes made to the Federal New Source Performance Standards rules into the Georgia rules. This revision is administrative in nature, is in no way any more restrictive than the Federal requirements, and does not incur any additional costs to the regulated industry or public.

Rule 391-3-1-.02(9) – Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants  
The basis of this rule is to adopt the National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants. The purpose for this revision is to adopt new standards and update an existing standard in order to make the Georgia rules consistent with the National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants. This revision is administrative in nature, is in no way any more restrictive than the Federal requirements, and does not incur any additional costs to the regulated industry or public.

Rule 391-3-1-.14 – General Conformity  
The basis of this rule is to adopt the Federal General Conformity requirements by reference. The purpose for this revision is to update the entire rule in order to include all changes made to the Federal General Conformity requirements into the Georgia rules.

**Summary** Rule 391-3-1-.15 – Transportation Conformity

The basis of this paragraph is to specify a rule that incorporates the Clean Air Act requirements for Transportation Conformity. The rule references the applicable Statute and Federal regulations and references a separate document, the Transportation Conformity Manual. The manual contains the specific details that identify the affected agencies, their responsibilities, and the procedures they are to follow to determine the conformity of plans, programs, and projects in nonattainment areas. Conformity means that affected actions shall not contribute to, increase the frequency or severity of, or delay the attainment of the NAAQS in any area. The purpose of this revision is to specify the Georgia interagency consultation, enforcement, and enforceability procedures for the determination of conformity of metropolitan planning organization (MPO) plans, programs and projects. This requirement was previously implemented by a Memorandum of Agreement between the State, Federal, and regional agencies affected by the Federal transportation conformity rule.

This revision will formally adopt, as required by the Clean Air Act, the transportation conformity procedures that are currently followed by the affected agencies and will impose no new restrictions on the affected agencies. There will be no increased costs to the public.

**Rules to be Amended:** 391-3-6

**Summary** The proposed rule amendments include revisions to Chapter 391-3-6 “Rules and Regulations for Water Quality Control” as follows:  
Rule 391-3-6-.08 – Pretreatment and Permit Requirements is proposed for amendment by incorporating federal changes to the following sections:

1. Section (2): adds five definitions and broadens two definitions.
2. Section (3): updates local limits to include Best Management Practices (BMPs) and added flexibility of expression of pretreatment standards in permits as either concentration-based or flow-based standards.
3. Section (5): updates signatory requirements.
4. Section (8): adds new levels of Industrial User (IU) classification with reduced monitoring frequencies.
5. Subparagraphs (3), (4), (5), (7), (8), and (9) were revised to replace, in some instances, the word “Approval Authority” with “Control Authority”, and to clarify the requirements for POTWs and EPD.
6. Subparagraph (9): corrected the reference to the right to an appeal of an order or action of the EPD Director.

Rule 391-3-6-.09 – Requirements for Approval and Implementation of Publicly Owned Treatment Works Pretreatment Program and Administration of the EPD Pretreatment Program is proposed for amendment by incorporating federal changes to the following sections:

1. Section (4) and (5): adds requirements for EPD to review, provide responses, provide notification, and approve or deny a submission of a pretreatment program proposal. Also updates the characteristics of the newspaper for public notice and adds procedure for EPA’s objection to EPD’s decision on approval of a pretreatment program.
2. Section (6): defines incorporation of a pretreatment program into a POTW’s NPDES permit as a minor modification.
3. Section (8): updates sampling and inspection requirements to include new industrial user classifications and pollutant waiver option, requirements of the slug control plan evaluation, and monitoring and analysis requirements of POTW and industrial users. Adds requirements for including best management practices compliance information in monitoring reports, recordkeeping to include best management practices information, annual certification, and change in discharge notification. Also adds the procedure for accepting electronic reports.
4. Section (9): allows POTWs to develop general permits if specific conditions are met. Specifies that EPD shall have the authority to take additional enforcement action for insufficient enforcement response by a POTW.
5. Section (10): updates the requirements of the pretreatment program annual report.
