Summary In addition to confirming that eligible telecommunications carriers (“ETCs”) are obligated to meet the requirements set forth in 47 U.S.C. §214(e)(1), the proposed rules require ETCs to offer a basic Lifeline service that must be capped at the incumbent local exchange carrier’s retail R-1 rate.
