**Summary** The Commission's primary goal in this proceeding is to require, at a minimum, all natural gas Operators in Georgia to establish, as an integral part of the natural gas safety plan mandated by Commission Rule 515-9-7-.01; procedures for handling Areas of Natural Gas Emerencies (as defined in the proposed rule) occuring on the facilites of another Operator. Such procedures and the operator training required pursuant to 49 C.F.R. Parts 191 and 192 therefore are wholly necessary and critical to the health, welfare and safety of the public at large as well as Georgia's natural gas distribution and transmission systems and shall alleviate gaps in emergency response in areas of close proximity and/or in which overlapping natural gas distribution and/or transmission facilities reside. Such procedures and the training required pursuant to 49 C.F.R. Parts 191 and 192 therefore are further critical to the elimination and/or minimization of confusion, delay and unnecessary danger to the public and first responders whenever a natural gas emergency should arise (Commission Rule 515-9-7-.01(3)(a). **Summary** It is proposed to amend rule 40-4-1-.01(1)(c) to increase the license fee from \$25.00 to \$50.00. The license fee has not been increased in more than 15 years.

It is proposed to amend rule 40-4-1-.01(2), concerning the license period. The current license is a lifetime license with no expiration date or renewal requirement. The Department is proposing to change this rule so that a license would expire on December 31st of each year.

The Department is proposing to change 40-4-1-.04(6) and institute an inspection fee for out of state certification. Approximately half of the honey bee inspections conducted by the Department are for out-of-state certification, and currently there is no charge for this service. The Department is currently limited to certifying colonies to be free from *Acarapis woodi* and *Varroa destructor*, and now we are proposing to add the statement "or other bee pest" to this certification. The current rule requires that beekeepers request an inspection from the Department 60 days prior to movement out of state and the Department is proposing to reduce this period to 15 days.
